SEARCH FOR A PRIMARY CARE PHYSICIAN (PCP)

1. Log onto www.whyuhc.com/csveba
2. Click on the plan you are enrolling in
 - ▶ CS VEBA Performance HMO - Network 1
 - ▶ CS VEBA Performance HMO - Network 2
 - ▶ Search the network: UnitedHealthcare SignatureValue® CS VEBA Alliance
3. A primary care provider information page pops up – just click the  at the top right to close

5. Once you find a physician, click on their name then click on to locate the **ID: XXXXXXXXXX**
6. Use this number to enter into Workday when asked for your provider.
