

Vice President's Report – Grossmont College

April, 2014

The Leadership Council did not meet in April as a table top evacuation was held in its place. Steve Nunez, Exercise Planner from Cal OES was the moderator/leader of the drill. The scenario was a regional wildfire with situations including residents being evacuated from their east county homes and being directed to the Grossmont campus where they could stay in their motor homes and services were provided to residents and animals. Eventually the entire campus was evacuated. Several recommendations came out of the exercise that will help us to be better prepared for future emergencies.

Rochelle Weiser provided me with the following report from the Planning and Resources Council meeting:

Yesterday at the Planning and Resources Council meeting we discussed the meeting with the College Brain Trust Consultants that PRC members will be attending on Tuesday. Our college and district will be engaging in a staffing analysis to determine levels of staffing in comparison to other colleges our size. My understanding is that this information will be used as we plan future staffing and was also an accreditation recommendation. This is our opportunity to bring forward any questions or concerns we might have regarding classified staffing or information that might be helpful to the group that will be doing the analysis. You can have staff members e-mail questions, information or concerns and I will carry them forward on Tuesday. I will also plan on bringing information regarding the number of staffing requests we received this year.

In other news:

We are in the process of hiring a Vice President of Student Services, Dean of Counseling Services and Administrative Assistant IV in Administrative Services.

Screening committees are being formed for a Business Communications Supervisor, Counseling Supervisor, Business Communication Specialist and Student Services Assistant in the Assessment Center.
