- Public Comment—<u>Items on the Docket</u>—People who wish to address the Board about an item on the agenda should submit a *Request for Public Presentation* (white card) to the Board Secretary prior to commencement of the meeting. Requests may also be submitted later in the meeting, but prior to Board consideration of the item. In accordance with *BP 2350 Speakers*, each speaker will be allowed a maximum of four minutes per topic, twenty minutes maximum for public speakers on any one subject, regardless of the number of speakers.
- Public Presentations—In accordance with Education Code Section 72121.5, citizens are invited to participate in the governance system of the District. <a href="Items not on the Docket">Items not on the Docket</a>—Persons wishing to speak on items not on the agenda should submit a Request for Public Presentation (blue card) to the Board Secretary prior to commencement of the meeting. The Board shall take no action other than an action of referral. Each presentation shall be limited to four minutes. The Board may refer items to the Chancellor for follow-up. Requests to have presentation item(s) placed on the agenda must be submitted at least two weeks prior to the Board meeting, in accordance with BP 2340 Agendas.
- Adjourn to Closed Session: In accordance with the Ralph M. Brown Act, the Governing Board will adjourn to closed session until approximately 7:00 p.m., in the Cuyamaca College Communication Arts Building Room B-160, pursuant to Government Code Section 54957 to consider the employment of President, Cuyamaca College; and Section 54956.9 to confer with legal counsel regarding Cliffe v. GCCCD.
