- 108 **Public Comment**—<u>Items on the Docket</u>–People who wish to address the Board about an item on the agenda should submit a *Request for Public Presentation* (white card) to the Board Secretary prior to commencement of the meeting. Requests may also be submitted later in the meeting, but prior to Board consideration of the item. In accordance with *BP 2350 Speakers*, each speaker will be allowed a maximum of four minutes per topic, twenty minutes maximum for public speakers on any one subject, regardless of the number of speakers.
