In accordance with *BP 2350 Speakers*, each speaker will be allowed a maximum of four minutes per topic, twenty minutes maximum for public speakers on any one subject, regardless of the number of speakers.
- 109 **Public Presentations**—In accordance with Education Code Section 72121.5, citizens are invited to participate in the governance system of the District. <u>Items not on the Docket</u>—Persons wishing to speak on items not on the agenda should submit a *Request for Public Presentation* (blue card) to the Board Secretary prior to commencement of the meeting. The Board shall take no action other than an action of referral. Each speaker shall be limited to four minutes per topic, twenty minutes maximum for public speakers on any one subject, regardless of the number of speakers. The Board may refer items to the Chancellor for follow-up.
