## Report of the Chancellor

Chancellor Suarez reported the County of San Diego has requested representation from the Governing Board to serve on the Policy Steering Committee for the County Suburban Transit Study. Board President Kendrick agreed to consult with Trustees to determine who will represent the Board on the steering committee.

Suarez invited Director of Institutional Research Phillips to present the Districtwide Strategic Plan. Phillips acknowledged the Strategic Planning Committee and Steering Committee members in attendance, and reviewed the Vision and Mission statements and Areas of Focus of the Plan, which was developed through the shared governance process and based on principles of *The Way Forward*. Chancellor Suarez reported that, through the Strategic Plan, the District will move forward in a common direction. He expressed support of the two colleges retaining their individual vision statements, and noted that each of the three vision statements convey the same message—providing excellent opportunities for students. The Chancellor and Governing Board commended Phillips and the Districtwide Strategic Planning Committee for their outstanding work on the Plan.
