A special meeting of the Governing Board of the Grossmont-Cuyamaca Community College District was held on Tuesday, February 19, 2002, at 5:30 p.m., in Room 220, Grossmont College, 8800 Grossmont College Drive, El Cajon, California.

Grossmont College Music Department Presentation

Shannon O'Dunn, Dean, Communication and Fine Arts, presented an overview of the Communication Arts Division, which consists of six departments—Art, Music, Dance, Theatre Arts, Speech, and Media Communications—with 297 sections and an enrollment of 9,000 students. She introduced Steve Baker, Music Department Chair, who shared information about the Music Department, which has 27 faculty members and an enrollment of 1,500 students. Baker introduced Dr. Randall Tweed, Instructor, voice and instruments, who presented an overview of the Grossmont Symphony and Chamber Chorale, and invited the Board to attend a March 15 Celtic program at the East County Performing Arts Center. Dean O'Dunn led a tour, which included a visit to a Music class taught by Marian Rodewald and a harpsichord performance by instructor Kathleen Scheide.
