Call to Order

Board President Alexander called the special meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Report of the Board President

Board President Alexander issued the Oath of Office to Rick Collins, Cuyamaca College, and Richard Ferrell, Grossmont College, Student Trustees for 2002-2003. They were welcomed with a round of applause.

Workshop—Tentative Budget for 2002-2003

Chancellor Suarez expressed appreciation to all who were involved in putting the budget together. He noted it will be a lean year in light of the state budget deficit, and described strategies the District has embarked upon, including a soft freeze on hiring, travel, and equipment purchases, since January 2002. He invited Vice Chancellor Austin to present the Tentative Budget for 2002-2003.

Austin provided an overview of the state budget process as it relates to community colleges, and described the process used in developing the District budget. Presidents Perri and Martinez reviewed their respective college budget processes, and Sue Rearic, District Controller, reviewed the Tentative Budget.

Board President Alexander adjourned the meeting at 8:40 p.m.
