Call to Order

Board President Alexander called the special meeting to order at 4:03 p.m.

Workshop—Tentative Budget for 2007-2008

Chancellor Suarez welcomed everyone to the Tentative Budget Workshop and stated the focus is on money for growth, raising a challenge as to whether the colleges can grow to benefit from the additional resources available to community colleges.

Interim Vice Chancellor-Business Services Rearic presented the Tentative Budget for 2007/2008, which was provided in three parts: Part 1—2007/2008 Tentative Budget, including General Fund, unrestricted and restricted; Part 2—The May Revise and expectations for the signed State budget in July; and Part 3—Supplemental funds. Rearic provided an overview of District services and Districtwide budget. President Perri and Interim President Colli reviewed the developing site budgets.

Dana Quittner, Associate Vice Chancellor, Intergovernmental Relations, Economic Development, and Public Information, provided legislative information on the politics of the May Revise and State budget.
