### Report of the Board President

Board President Garrett said remarks by Director of Campus Facilities and Operations Tim Flood at the Grossmont College Convocation were a reminder that during trying times, the District knows how to do things right.

# **Reports of the Governing Board**

Board Members, students, faculty, and staff extended warm congratulations to Grossmont College President Cooke and to her team on the inspiring convocation.

Trustee Weeks attended the Nurse Pinning Ceremony and the Corrections Academy graduation; and extended compliments on the Student Success discussion at the pre-board meeting.

Trustee Barr expressed that there may be budget problems, but there are no inter-relation problems, which is priceless.

Trustee Rosinski attended the Corrections Academy graduation and extended compliments on District programs.

Trustee Alexander thanked Grossmont Schools Federal Credit Union for providing the Grossmont College Convocation breakfast.

Grossmont College Student Trustee Enders expressed his excitement to be going with a group of District advocates to Washington, D.C. He attended the Corrections Academy graduation, Nurse Pinning Ceremony, and met with Senator Mark Wyland and Assemblyman Joel Anderson.

Cuyamaca College Student Trustee Taylor reported on sales and distribution of student benefit cards, and operating the sales concession at recent basketball games.

#### Report of the Chancellor

Chancellor Miles reported on the upcoming budget and community colleges advocacy groups going to Washington, D.C., and Sacramento; recognized staff for work on the District Services survey and Action Plans, now posted to the intranet; and reported on the status of hiring for critical positions. She also congratulated Director of Employment Services Amber Green on attaining certification as a Senior Professional of Human Resources by a national institution.

Police Chief Joel Javines provided an update on campus closure and activities during the winter storm and the opportunity to open the Emergency Operation Centers and practice the Incident Command System.

Vice Chancellor Business Services Sue Rearic provided a budget update stating the District is awaiting the 2008-2009 budget re-calculation and that in February we will know if additional adjustments are necessary. She said the 2009-2010 budget takes into account a \$10M deficit, contains growth, and a negative cost of living adjustment (COLA), but it is too early to assess.

President Cooke and Interim President Manzoni provided reports highlighting campus activities, events, and honors. The Presidents' Reports were distributed.

The 2008-2009 Auxiliary and Foundations' activities reports were presented by Cuyamaca College Foundation President Sharon Bullard, Grossmont College Foundation President Steve Devan, and Auxiliary Executive Director Stan Schroeder.

AF Consultants principal Tony Fulton provided reports on the 2008-2009 *Proposition R* Bond Building Performance audit and on the program performance review.
