

GOVERNING BOARD MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING Tuesday, March 20, 2012

Following a Conflicts of Law Board Workshop, the regular meeting of the Governing Board of the Grossmont-Cuyamaca Community College District began at 5:25 p.m. in the Cuyamaca College Student Center at 900 Rancho San Diego Parkway, El Cajon, California.

Board President Garrett called the meeting to order at 5:25 p.m.

Board President Garrett adjourned the open session at 5:35 p.m., and the Board met in closed session until approximately 6:37 p.m., in the Cuyamaca College Student Center Room I-209, pursuant to Education Code Section 76030 to consider permanent expulsion of one Grossmont College student; Government Code Section 54956.9(b) to confer with legal counsel regarding significant exposure to one potential litigation case; Section 54957 to consider discipline/dismissal/release of an employee and Chancellor performance evaluation; and Section 54957.6 to confer with the District Chief Negotiator regarding bargaining matters concerning Administrators' Association, American Federation of Teachers (AFT), California School Employees Association Chapter 707 (CSEA), and confidential administrators and staff.

Reports of the Governing Board

Trustee Rosinski expressed appreciation to Timothy Garfield for the Conflicts of Law Board Workshop.

Trustee Barr and his wife attended the Grossmont College Theatre Department production of *The 25th Annual Putnam County Spelling Bee*.

Trustee Justeson expressed condolences on the passing of Grossmont College adjunct math faculty member Oscar Larios.

Trustee Hiel expressed what a privilege it was to serve on an accreditation team; and that through the experience, he noted that the GCCCD Educational Master Plan represents everything the accreditation process is about – guiding the institution for continuous improvement and review.

Grossmont College Student Trustee Enders expressed appreciation to Chancellor Miles and President Cooke for their support in his transfer and acceptance to UC San Diego.

Report of the Board President

Board President Garrett, his wife, and guests attended the Grossmont College Theatre Department production of *The 25th Annual Putnam County Spelling Bee.* He expressed appreciation to Sr. Director Facilities Planning, Development and Maintenance Dale Switzer for a tour of the new Grossmont College Student and Administrative Services Building and Griffin Center.

Report of the Chancellor

Chancellor Miles reported another 477 sections would be cut on top of the 1,600 eliminated over the past three years; and that the District is working with consultation councils to come up with budget solutions to prepare a balanced 2012/2013 budget. She reported on the status of a bond for the November ballot, commenting that based on the positive survey, the District will continue to cautiously move forward.

Grossmont College President Cooke reported on the upcoming 50th Anniversary Open House; a World Arts and Culture Club Chinese New Year celebration; and a tour of the Health & Sciences Building and nursing simulation lab that greatly impressed a visiting group of physicians and health educators from Japan.

Cuyamaca College President Zacovic reported that student leaders participated in the *March in March* in Sacramento; student Viviana Vasiu received the statewide Phi Theta Kappa scholarship award and recognition as one of the top twenty community college students in the state; and asked for a moment of silence in memory of Economics and Real Estate Instructor Lowell Knapp.

Vice Chancellor Sue Rearic reported the District was prepared for the \$6.3 million midyear cut, but also took a second cut of \$2.8 million because of a shortfall in student fees and taxes, which was covered by savings. She said the District will face significant additional cuts if the tax initiative does not pass in the November election. The District's 2012/2013 budget will be built on the assumption the tax measure does not pass and would mean another major workload reduction. Rearic reported over the past four years, the District has incurred a loss of \$35 million in state funding cuts and lost revenue.
