

RESOLUTION 20-021

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
GROSSMONT-CUYMACA COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT

SETTING THE DISTRICT APPROPRIATIONS
LIMIT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021
AS REQUIRED BY SENATE BILL 1352,
CHAPTER 1205 OF 1980

On the motion of Member Debbie Justeson, seconded by Member Brad Monroe,
the following resolution is adopted:

WHEREAS, on November 6, 1979, the people of California passed *Proposition 4*, a constitutional amendment requiring appropriations limits for state and local government units; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1352, Chapter 1205, Statutes of 1980, implements *Proposition 4* and requires the Governing Board to establish by resolution an appropriations limit each fiscal year beginning with 1981-1982; and

WHEREAS, this Board has directed that the appropriations limit for fiscal year 2020-2021 be developed in accordance with the provisions of Senate Bill 1352; and

WHEREAS, the documentation used in determining the revised appropriations limit for fiscal year 2020-2021 has been made available to the public in the District Office for fifteen (15) days prior to the adoption of this resolution.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Governing Board hereby establishes a fiscal year 2020-2021 appropriations limit of \$158,942,395.
