

Philosophy & Religious Studies Equivalencies

Philosophy:

A Master's degree in one of the areas of the Humanities and at least 18 units of upper division or graduate level coursework in Philosophy

OR

A Master's degree in Religious Studies or Theology and at least 12 units of upper division or graduate level coursework in Philosophy

NOTE: Coursework in Classics, Greek, Latin, etc., may be regarded as acceptable if it is clear that the course content was essentially Philosophy (e.g., a Greek course whose primary objective was to read works of Plato in the original Greek, or a German course whose primary objective was to read works of Kant in the original German)

Religious Studies

A Master's degree in one of the areas of the Humanities and at least 18 units of upper division or graduate level coursework in Religious Studies or Theology
