Personal Safety Awareness Tips

- Never leave valuables in your vehicle, even when locked. Place all belongings in the trunk of your vehicle.
- Never leave your office keys unattended. Purchase a small clip or belt loop so you have to consciously place keys back on it. This helps prevent loss of important keys.
- If you believe an individual seems suspicious, notify security. Be sure to note details about the person's appearance so that you can thoroughly describe her/him.
- Never give out personal information over the phone to a caller who called you without notice. A deputy or official will never ask for information such as a Social Security number, pin number or bank account number.
- Exercise common sense and be aware of your surroundings, no matter where you are.

- When walking by yourself, get off your cell phone and walk with purpose, making eye contact. If someone follows you look confident, do not engage in conversation and change directions if needed.
- Get to know your building and co-workers. Never be afraid to ask a stranger for identification. You can also ask them if they are lost or need help finding something.
