## ☐ Define the "promise" criteria

- Graduate from GUHSD with at least a GPA 2.0\*
- 2-year residency in GUHSD\*
- Complete Higher Edge Action Plan
  - (Orientation, assessment/placement, education plan, and apply for FAFSA & BOG Waiver)
- Successfully complete a <u>Counseling College Success Course</u>
- Participate in one of the following:
  - Dual Enrollment
  - (3) College Engagement Events
  - Higher Edge Boot Camp
- Begin college within 1 year after high school graduation
- Enroll at least half time in college and remain academically eligible

<sup>\*</sup>Or successful completion of Higher Edge Boot Camp and completion of the College Intervention Plan
